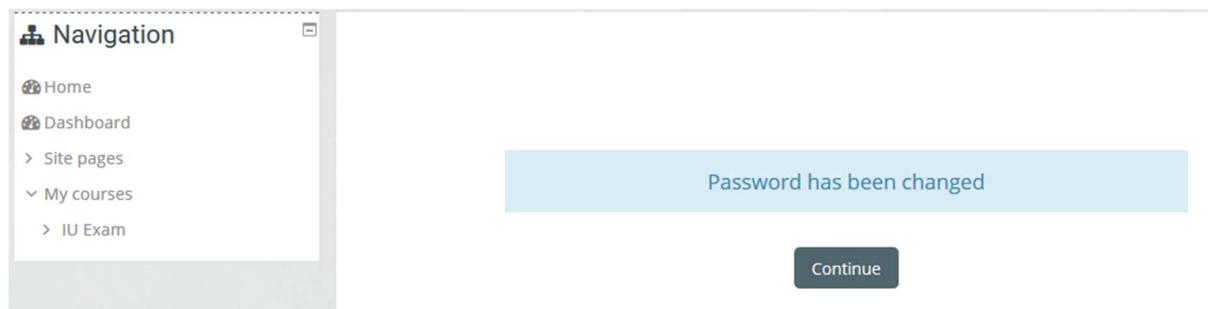
SUBJECT: 2020 ITTF International Umpire Exam. Moodle instructions.

Dear National Coordinators for the International Umpire,

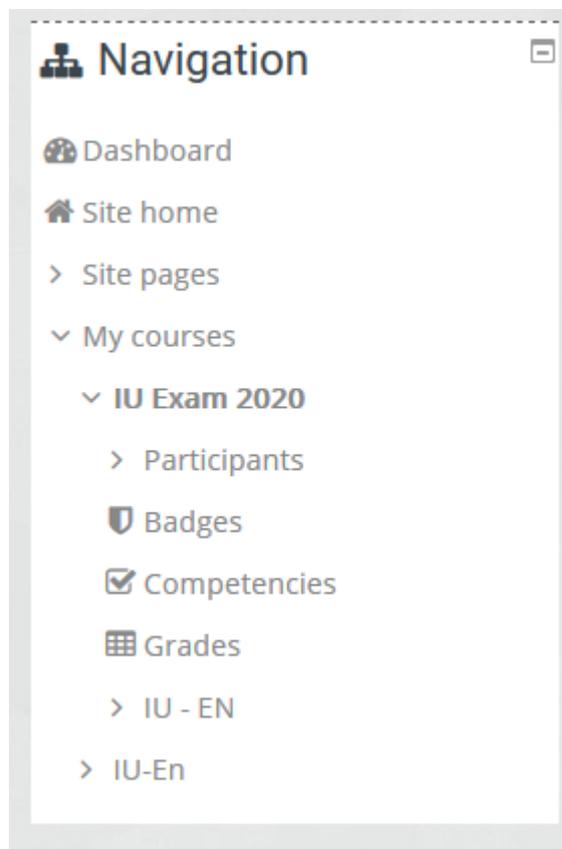
Each of the candidates will have received (or should soon receive) an email with their username and password, as well as a link to the ITTF Education site which is hosting this year's international umpire exam. If the link is highlighted in blue just click on it, otherwise copy and paste the link into your web browser. When you click on the link the [Log in](#) screen appears. On the top right of the screen, next to your name, you will see a small globe icon with a drop-down arrow beside it. Clicking on this arrow will allow you to change the language you are reading the screen. **However, you will only be able to do the exam in the language your Association specified on the application form.**



When logging in for the first time, for security reasons, your temporary password must be changed. Once you have done this the following screen appears



On the left-hand side you will see a box titled Navigation



Click on IU-En (language in which you will be doing the exam)

Once the password has been changed, you must upload a copy of your passport or, if you don't have a current passport, some other identification document which shows your name, date of birth and a photo. Click on [ID scan](#), then [Add submission](#). Add a file by clicking on the [Files](#) icon or just drag and drop the appropriate file. Once the file is there click on [Save changes](#). It is best if this is done as soon as possible so that on the day you do the exam everything will be ready to just do it. Please ensure that you have a valid picture to upload. The file format must be either GIF, JPEG, PNG or other image file used on the web such as .svg or .svgz. You can only upload 1 file with a maximum size of 500KB.

On the day you do the exam, you will need to click on the link again to access the ITTF Education website, put in your username and new password, and proceed to [IU exam](#) as detailed above. When this is done the next step is to proceed to the exam by either clicking on the appropriate language and then [IU examination](#) on the left-hand side, or by selecting [NEXT ACTIVITY IU examination](#) on the bottom right of the screen. This will bring up the instructions about the exam. Read these carefully and make sure you understand them before attempting the exam. The time allowed for the exam is 60 minutes, and as soon as you click on [Attempt quiz now](#) the countdown timer will start.

The exam itself is presented in blocks of 5 questions. Once you have answered those 5 questions click on [Next page](#) for the next 5 questions. At the top left of the screen you will see Quiz navigation with all 50 questions shown. To review answers, or to answer any you may have missed, click on the question and a page of 5 questions will appear. To correct an answer just click on the new answer.

When you have finished answering the questions, on the bottom right of the screen you will see

If you are reviewing questions, this is also shown in the Quiz navigation section just above the timer.

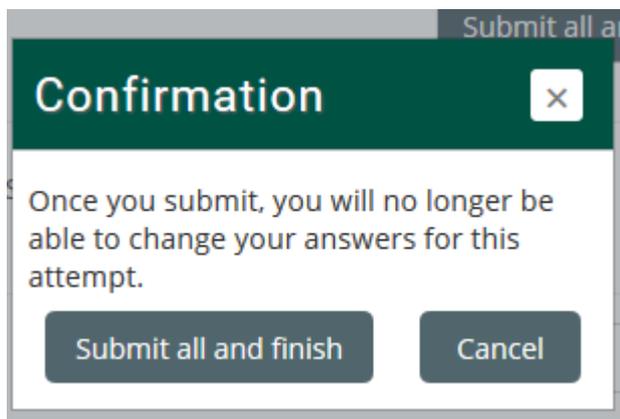
